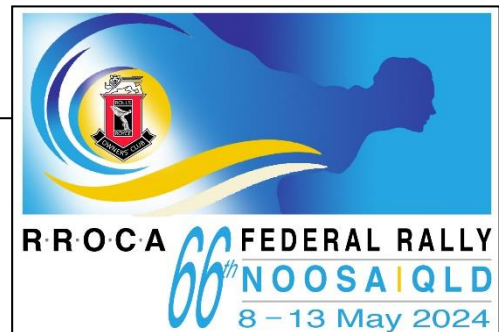

Scenic Drive to Boreen Point and Kin Kin \$60 per person.

Enjoy the stunning scenery of the hinterland north of Noosa as you wind through the hills and valleys to the gorgeous township of Boreen Point on the shores of Lake Cootharaba. Morning Tea will be served at the 150 year old Apollonian Hotel, with its wide lawns, shady verandas and irresistible ambience. Kin Kin, a picturesque and historic town which has embraced the abundance of local produce and artistic talent is only another half-hour's drive, where lunch will be served.

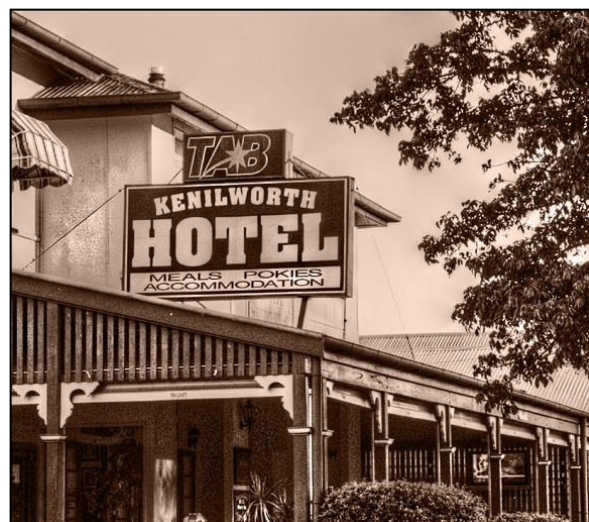
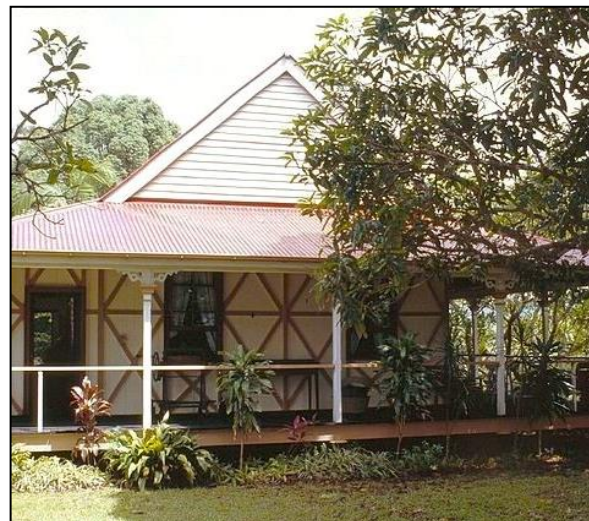
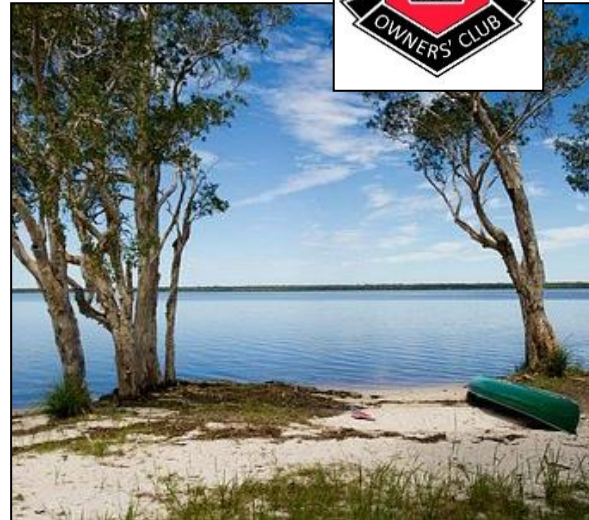
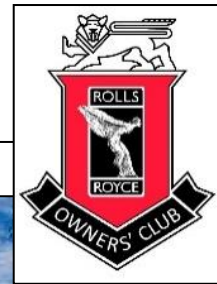
Friday 10th May

Scenic drive to Koongalba House and Kenilworth - included in the Rally package.

Drive south to indulge in the time-honoured tradition of Devonshire Tea in the delightful precinct of Koongalba House. Sip on the perfect cup of tea or coffee paired with freshly baked scones and a choice of preserves from the Yandina Ginger Factory commencing at 10.00am.

Steeped in history, Koongalba at 12 Wharf Street, Yandina was built by John Anthony Low (great-grandfather of Rally Committee Chairman, Frank Carroll) in 1894. The Low family were the first European settlers in Yandina and were influential in the development of the timber industry in the Mooloolah-Maroochy area from the 1860's. It was added to the Queensland Heritage Register in 1995. Koongalba will provide a glorious photo opportunity for our historic cars.

Then drive up over the Blackall Range for lunch at Kenilworth with its 1930's atmosphere where visitors enjoy a very engaging historical museum, a range of eateries, fabulous shops, art gallery and a cheese, yogurt and ice-cream factory. As you explore the quaint township of Kenilworth choose your own venue for lunch at your own expense. Kenilworth Hotel and McGinn's Cafe are two great spots. Back to Noosa by 3:30pm.





Saturday 11th May
Concours Judging - 8am to 12noon

Concours entrants will travel approximately 20km south to St Andrew’s Anglican College in Peregian Springs and be directed to the new underground car parking facility for judging.

Morning tea and lunch will be included for Federal Judges, assistants and entrants.

Members are welcome to view the beautifully presented Rolls-Royce and Bentley motor cars as judges cast their eyes over them. A café is located nearby for you to enjoy refreshments.


